- Pies are donated to the contest.
- Entries may be made by persons, businesses or organizations – but pies may not be store bought. (Unless of course, your business is making pies!)
- Multiple entries are permitted.
- Pies should be delivered to the Manor Park Community Centre before 4pm on September 6, 2019.
- Pies must be accompanied by an ingredients list. (This helps those with food allergies.)
- Any pie plates that should be returned following the contest, must be marked with name and email address.
- Judging panel is selected by the Manor Park Community Council. (What a great job!) The decision of the judges is final.
- The winning baker need not be in attendance at the event. (But, we hope you are!)
- The winning baker agrees to allow the Manor Park Community Council to publish the recipe on social media and in the Manor Park Chronicle.
- Pie plates may be picked up at the Community Centre at 8pm on the evening of the event.
