- Any pie plates that should be returned to the baker following the contest, must be marked with name and email address.
- Judging panel is selected by the Manor Park Community Council. (What a great job!) The
 decision of the judges is final.
- The winning baker need not be in attendance at the event. (But, we hope you are!)
- The winning baker agrees to allow the Manor Park Community Council to publish the recipe on our website, in social media and in the Manor Park Chronicle.
- Pie plates may be picked up at the Community Centre at 7:30pm on the evening of the event.
